### PAYMENT OF FEES

Daar Aisha College is an independent organization. Tuition fees are payable on a term-by-term basis. Students need to register for each term. The fees schedule is as follows:

# **Registration Fee**

A non-refundable registration fee of \$25 is payable annually per student.

### **Tuition Fees:**

Fees are paid before the commencement of each Term.

There are 2 modes of payment for fees:

- 1. Term fees paid in advance: Cash, Cheque, Eftpos, Internet Banking.
- 2. Instalments via Ezidebit. Request the form from the Administration Office.

Fees are payable for the duration of time a student is registered at Daar Aisha College including days of absence.



## Cancellation & Refund

Fees are refundable & transferable up to **7 days prior** to the commencement of the course, however a cancellation fee of \$20 applies.

Fees are non refundable and non transferable from 7 days prior to the commencement of the course

# **DISCONTINUATION OF STUDIES**

Your child's discontinuation will be effective at the End of Term.

Cancellation of Ezidebit payment of fees will be effective as of End of Term



# **UNIFORM & DRESS CODE**

Since the classes are conducted in the Condell Park Masjid Complex, Junior Shariah Students attending classes at Daar Aisha College are required to adhere to a specific dress code.
